

## ***Power Wheels Derby Rules***

1. Classes will consist of two age groups: 3 to 6 and 7 to 10 years old. Power Wheel body style will also determine classes.
2. All participants must provide and wear a helmet, long pants, a long sleeved shirt and closed toe shoes during the contest.
3. Participants should be at the Fairgrounds 60 minutes prior to the contest for inspection of Power Wheels entry.
4. Vehicle doors and hood must be secured so that they will not open during the contest (Zip ties or duct tape are recommended).
5. Seat belts are not mandatory but are recommended.
6. No special reinforcement of the vehicle is allowed – vehicle must be consistent with form in which it was manufactured by Power Wheels.
7. Vehicle height may not be altered (neither front nor rear may be raised or lowered from manufacturer's specifications).
8. Original battery may be replaced with a battery no larger than a 12 volt lawn mower battery. Battery may be positioned anywhere inside the vehicle except for the driver or passenger seating areas. Battery must be secured to vehicle and completely covered.
9. No alterations to vehicle tires are allowed. No screws, Velcro, or any other material may be attached to tires.
10. Nothing may be added to reinforce strength.
11. Painting, numbering, and decorating of the vehicle are strongly encouraged.
12. Event will consist of Demolition Derby style driving. Participants will be given two balloons which must be secured to the front and rear bumper of their vehicle. Once the contest begins, drivers will attempt to pop or dislodge balloons from competitors' vehicles. Once both balloons are dislodged or popped on the driver's vehicle, driver is disqualified from the contest and driver will stop moving vehicle. As needed, contest will be temporarily stopped, so driver and their vehicle may be removed from the contest area.
13. A child exiting the vehicle after the contest begins will result in disqualification.
14. All children must be accompanied by ONE legal parent or guardian. NO EXCEPTIONS. All other family and friends must be located outside of the track area.
15. All children will receive a participation ribbon. Trophy will be awarded to contest winner for each age division
16. Rules, dates and times are subject to change without notice.
17. Each age division will require at least 4 participants in order for contest to be held.
18. Contest entry form and \$5.00 entry fee should be submitted with postmark by Friday, July 7, 2017. Entries after July 7<sup>th</sup> and day of event will be \$10.00.
